- 2) **Resolve to exclude members of the press and public.** To agree any items to be dealt with after the public and press have been excluded as publicity would prejudice the public interest by reason of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted [Public Bodies(Admission to Meetings Act) 1960]. **Item 7d)** Pathway for Hall, exempt information relating to Business Affairs of a person and Quotes from a Contractor; and if required **Item 12).** Exempt information relating to negotiations about a Labour Relations matter (LGA '72, Sch 12a).

- 7) **a) Turbaries;** Hunting Policy resolve that a Review Working Group of three Cllrs, without Delegated Authority, meet with the Clerk to agree recommendations to come back to a further meeting for approval;
Information Panels, to note that the latest updates have been sent to Freeline in Exeter to complete the work required;
FiPL work, this scheme is for Capital grants to be decided by a local panel from the BH AONB and agreed that scrub clearance/ fencing on Horner would be a small project for this financial year to be carried out by the designated contractor who would need to provide maps/photos of the area done and dates for the work and would need 80% of costs to come from the grant; agreed;
The next Project would be notice boards for each Turbary beginning with Horner as agreed with Cllr A Thompkins;
WMP work as the November Minutes of the Turbary Committee showed Horner Hill (AG00291818) bramble & cherry laurel; the contractor to identify areas to cut for WMP and only topping can be taken as part of WMP conditions as well as dates of work with pre- and post-photos; contractor to contact the Managing Agent to see what to do on Horner cottages area and 1 day on WMP in Shortmoor (AG00305847).
b) Quantock; Shortmoor; & Bucehayes extensions yet to be decided and FWAG suggest making sure no parcels in the WMP are also part of the HLS/ELS Agreements.
c) Highways/Ditches and Footpaths;
d) Play Area, Car Park and Victory Hall; resolve to accept the offer from Cllr Ian Thomas, Chair of East Devon District Council re the Queen's Platinum Jubilee of an Oak Tree sapling to be planted on a suitable area;
Resolve to accept the opportunity to end the use of green lanes by recreational motor vehicles in Blackdown Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, submitted by Gleam UK in support of the Glover Report Consultation;
Resolve to accept the quote as a confidential item from a contractor for Stockland Village Hall to lay a new path-way area, strip, lay footings, build retaining wall, rough scat wall to match existing hall and then lay wheelchair access path and seating area, grading soil back where needed.
Agree to the support from the Village Hall Committee for this year.
